I APPRECIATE YOUR OFFER TO REPLACE THESE DEAD TREE EVEN THOUGH THE WEATHER HAD FAR MORE CAUSE AND EFFECT THAN YOUR TREE CONDITION. THIS SHOWS YOUR COMMITMENT TO YOUR GUARANTEE OF SATISFIED CUSTOMERS.
